

Rules and By-Laws of Atlanta Motorcycle Club

I. Officers of Atlanta Motorcycle Club will consist of the following:

II. Committees of Atlanta Motorcycle Club will consist of the following:

- A. Board of Trustees: Consisting of the six oldest members at all times. This Board is the Governing Body of all major disbursements. On each and every occasion, the club members shall be notified prior to major disbursement of funds exceeding one hundred dollars (100.00) or more, and the discharge of any like financial obligations. This committee will also be the governing body for the conduct of club members. \$500
- B. Activity Committee: Consisting of Five members. The Chairman will be elected and Four members shall be selected to serve with him. The responsibility of this committee will be creating activities for the club. Chairman is determined by the person receiving the most votes.
- C. Police Committee: Consisting of five members. The Chairman will be elected and four members shall be selected to serve with him. The responsibility of this committee will be to clean up the areas after an event.

III. Meetings:

- A. Club meetings are held the first Wednesday night of each month, beginning at 7:30 p.m.
- B. Any member that is late or caught wearing a hat during the meeting will be fined twenty-five cents.
- C. There will be at least six active members, in good standing, to conduct a regular club meeting. All business may be approved by the six or more members, other than major disbursements.
- D. Any club member caught fighting or causing any unnecessary disturbances will be tried by the club court on the first meeting night following the incident.
- E. For additions and amendments to the rules and by-laws of Atlanta Motorcycle Club, all paid-up club members will be notified by mail prior to said meeting night.
- F. The Order of Business shall be:
 1. Roll Call
 2. Reading of minutes of last meeting
 3. Visitors recognized
 4. Reports of Officers & Committees
 5. Unfinished Business
 6. New Business

- IV. Membership Dues: Club dues shall be ten dollars (10.00) per year, payable within sixty days (60) from acceptance date. If not paid within sixty days (60) member will be dropped from the roll. This regulation shall prevail as long as Atlanta Motorcycle Club exists.
- V. Club Parties and Functions: These events are limited to club member and spouse, or "date". Exceptions to the rule are provided only in the event prior approval is given at a regular club meeting. The club member will be responsible for all expenses incurred by the club for said guests.
- VI. New Membership:
- A. Any person desiring to become a member of AMC must be an AMA member or sign up through AMC prior to acceptance.
 - B. The new candidate for membership will be required to appear at three (3) regularly scheduled club meetings and/or club events. i.e., one (1) club meeting and two (2) events or two (2) club meetings and one (1) event.
 - C. Must own a motorcycle.
 - D. Must be sponsored by a club member in good standing.
 - E. Both sponsor and new candidate must be present before the candidate is voted on.
 - F. New membership application will be filed with the club secretary on the first meeting night after the new candidate has attended the three (3) meetings and/or events as required.
 - G. A secret ballot will then be cast.
- VII. Atlanta Motorcycle Club Life Membership:
- After twenty-five years (25) continuous membership, fully paid AMC members are no longer required to pay club membership dues.
- VIII. Participation in AMC Events:
- Entries for field events are limited to one passenger class and one solo driver class.
- VIIII. Election of Club Officers:
- Election of club officers will take place at each December meeting. Only club members are eligible to hold office.
- X. Copies of Rules and By-Laws will be distributed to each club member.
